How to get here by transportation:

From the Airport or other arrival destinations:

From where you're staying (Novotel or Ibis Hotel)

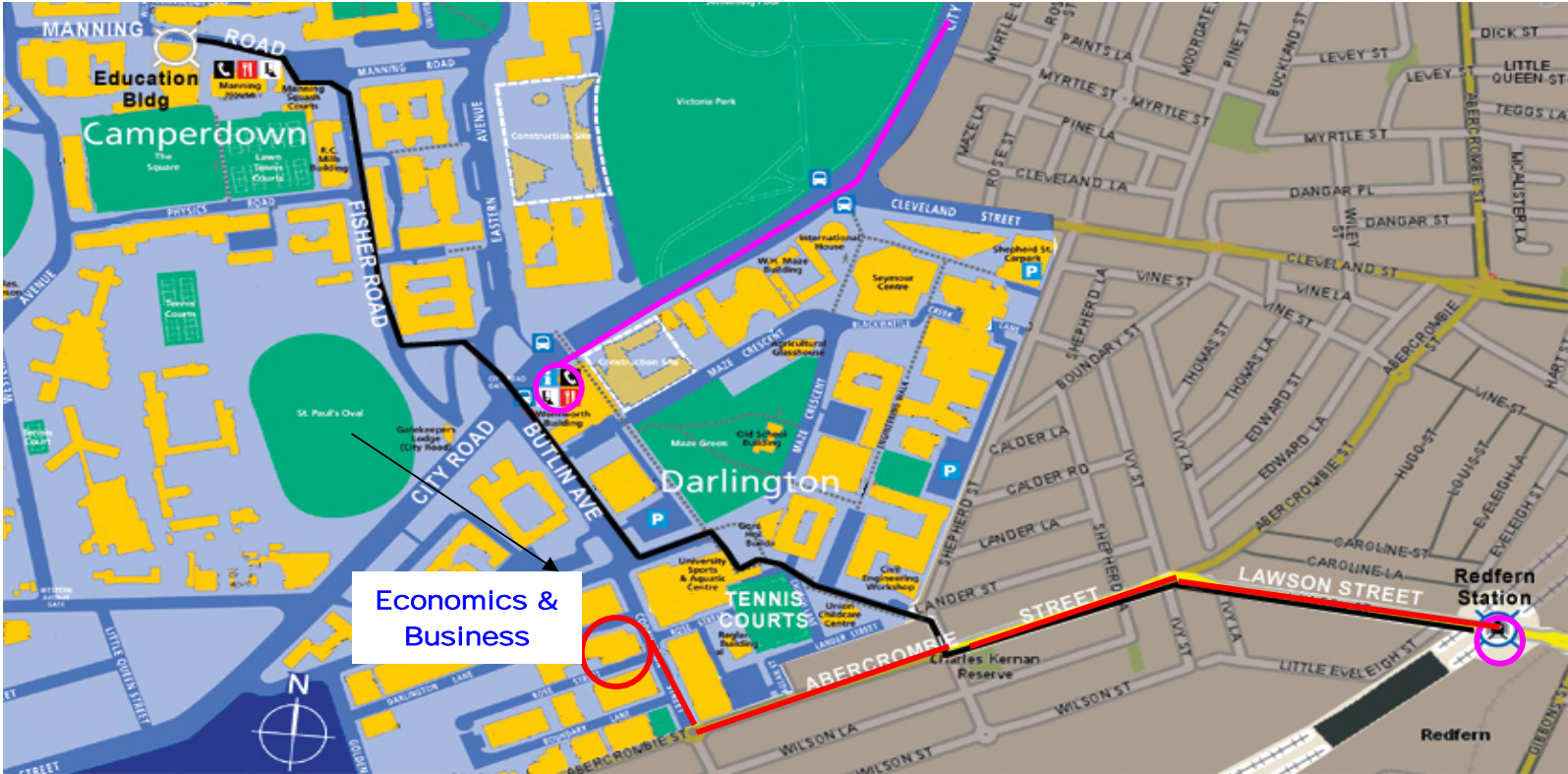
By Bus

1. Walk or catch light rail/monorail or the 501 bus from Harris street to Central Station.
Then from **Railway Square** catch either 422 or 423 buses.
2. Getting off at **City Road** in front of **Wentworth Building** intersecting **Butlin Avenue**.
3. Walk down **Butlin Avenue** and continue along as it changes into **Codrington Street** until you see the Economics & Business building (picture above) on your right.
4. Catch the lift to the 3rd floor and walk through the building, common room is at the end
5. Helpers will be around to make sure you don't get lost!




By train

1. From Central or Town hall Station, and catch a train to Redfern.
2. As you exit the station, turn left and walk approximately 500 meters to an intersection, turn left into **Abercrombie Street**.
3. Continue walking along **Abercrombie Street** until you reach a **round-a-bout**.
4. Turn right at the round-a-bout and walk along **Codrington street** and the Economics & Business Building is to your left.
5. Catch the lift to the 3rd floor and walk through the building, common room is at the end
6. Helpers will be around to make sure you don't get lost!

Event 2 –Symposium day 1: Powerhouse Museum

The Powerhouse Museum is adjacent to Darling Harbour and a short walk from Central Railway Station. A connecting covered walkway links the Museum to the Paddy's Market Monorail & Light Rail Stations and the Entertainment Centre's car park.

Buses: From either Ibis or Novotel

1. First walk to bus stop Pyrmont, **Harris St Nr Pyrmont Bridge Rd** - 656 metres
2. Then take the 501 bus (Sydney Buses)
 - a. **Departure: 8:14pm Pyrmont, Harris St Nr Pyrmont Bridge Rd**
Arrival: 8:17pm Ultimo, Harris St Nr MacArthur St
3. Finally walk to Powerhouse Museum Ultimo - 144 metres

Fastest route – Walking. Distance 800 meters

1. From either the IBIS or Novotel, exit the hotel on to Murray Street and turn left towards Allen Street
2. Walk down Allen Street until it meets the intersection to Harris Street
3. Turn left again and walk straight down Harris Street. Around 500 metres you would have arrived to your destination – the Powerhouse Museum

Monorail / Walking

Take the monorail to “City Centre” monorail station.

Walk up Market St and across Hyde Park to Art Gallery Road

Cross College St to Art Gallery Road bypassing St Mary’s Rd to your right and Hospital Road to your left.

Continue walking along Art Gallery Road until reaching Mrs Macquaries Rd.

Walk along the left Road of the diverged Mrs Macquarie Rd.

As you continue walking the Maiden Theatre will be to your left hand side.

Monorail / Bus

Take the monorail to “Galleries Victoria” monorail station.

Catch the #441 Bus near the corner of Pitt and Park Streets which runs to the Art Gallery of NSW on **Art Gallery Road**.

Then walk the short us walk or take a Taxi up to Mrs. Macquaries Road.
